Next week is the last week of after school clubs this term. There will be no after school clubs the first week back of the Summer term. A new list of clubs will be sent out during the first week back.

In class 1 we have had great fun writing about the adventures we had during the 'Great Race'. Many involved the oozy mud, many loved the cheering parents at the end, and of course receiving a medal. In maths we have been learning about multiplication and solving problems. In their topic they have been studying the work of Tony Plant, and continue to find out more about the emergency services.

Class Two, have continued with their topic The Town Mouse and the Country Mouse. This week, they have planned a diary entry, in relation to their picnic, with the Town Mouse, who they have all described as a little snooty and posh, although very polite. In math's, they have continued to learn about shape, as well as looking at reasoning skills in relation to solving problems, using all their math's skills. During the afternoons, they have been using the Bee-Bots to learn about directional language and map reading skills. In science they learnt about food chains in relation to habitats.

This week in Class 3 they began their new topic, 'Shake, Rock and Roll'. They have begun to investigate Earth's tectonic plates, and considering why earthquakes occur. In Maths, Year 3 have been solving multiplications using the grid method, and formal written method. Year 4 have been using 'distributive law' then the formal written method to multiply 2-digit by a 1-digit number.

In class 4, in Maths, they have been learning about conversions between different units of measurement. They have also been writing metaphorical poems with personification, and have begun to look at the geographical locations of many natural disasters.
