What have your children been learning?

In Class 1 this week they have been writing adjectives to describe creatures. In Maths they have been naming and sorting 3D shapes. For their topic work they have been finding animal pictures on the laptops.

This week class 2 have completed their fan letters and written poems relating to any aspect of their topic so far. In Maths , they have all been learning about time; year 2's to 5 minutes and year 3s to 1 minute. This has proven time consuming! They have designed a cross stitch design ready to begin stitching for DT.

This week class 3 have been learning about the circulatory system. Years four and five have been planning an information leaflet to educate another child of similar age about the human body, using formal and technical language. Year six having been writing extended stories using extended sentences and exploring more adventurous vocabulary. In Math's years four and five have been looking at how they can make a target number using their math's skills, year six are starting to budget for their theme park project. In science they have all completed observation of their own pulse rates and identified the key elements of the circulatory system. In art they have completed observational drawings/sketches of parts of the human body, our display is looking amazing.

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Following last weeks message about a friendly football game, please can you ensure you have let Miss Hicks or Mr Griffith know if your child would like to be on either team.


