Next week in class 1 they will be:

- Continuing to learn about different animals, classification, habitats and food.
- They will be re-visiting non-fiction books and the contents.
- They will also be learning to tell the time to the hour and half hour.

In Class 2:

- Next week year two will continue to learn about Queen Elizabeth 2nd and Queen Victoria. They will be writing a non-chronological report.
- In Maths they will continue to learn about time. Any support from you will be very helpful in supporting the children learning within school.
- In the afternoon they will continue to compare different periods in time.

In class 3 they will be:

- English Completing a non-chronological report about an animal living in the emergent layer of the rainforest before moving onto researching an animal who lives in the canopy layer of the rainforest.
- Maths Multiplication and division.
- Geography Plants and animals of the canopy layer of the rainforest.
- Guided Reading Answering comprehension questions about British Sign Language.

In class 4:

- Writing arguments focussed on the topic of evacuation.
- They will also be creating poetry depicting Britain during the Blitz.
- In maths the focus will be co-ordinates and positional symmetry.
- They will also be designing a shelter that could be built in our wild area.
