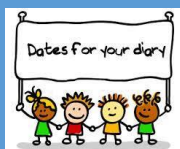

In Class 1, they have had great fun looking at rescue photos, then writing incident forms, that ranged from escaped lions to burning buildings. They all enjoyed World Book Day, and writing about their favourite part of their book. In Maths, they have been learning about directional language. In Science, they have been looking at habitats.

In Year Two this week, they have continued to work on stories about the Town Mouse and the Country Mouse. In Maths, they have been completing reasoning questions, using all their Math's skills. On Wednesday, they wrote an invitation to the Town Mouse, who then came to visit them for a picnic on Thursday morning. The children had great fun finding out about where he lives, and serving him some treats.

In science, they have continued to learn about habitats, and have started to complete a display in the classroom, to show what they have learnt. During DT, the children started to design and build a small model of a Town, for the Town Mouse, using nets to build 3D shapes. As well as the picnic on World Book Day, they also celebrated by discussing the amazing characters they had come dressed as, and every child made an individual book mark.

In Class 3 this week, they have listened to parts of 'Carnival of the Animals', and listed adjectives to describe the music used to represent the animals. They then used the adjectives to write poetic sentences to describe the musical instruments, and included similes to compare them to an animal. In Maths, they have been working with multiplication and division facts. Lots of times tables practise has been completed, using the iPads and laptops.

In Class 4, they have been investigating natural disasters, as part of their introduction to their new topic 'Angry Earth'. In Science, they have been interviewing Mr Coles about the creative and scientific elements of his job. Many thanks to Mr Coles for coming in to class today.

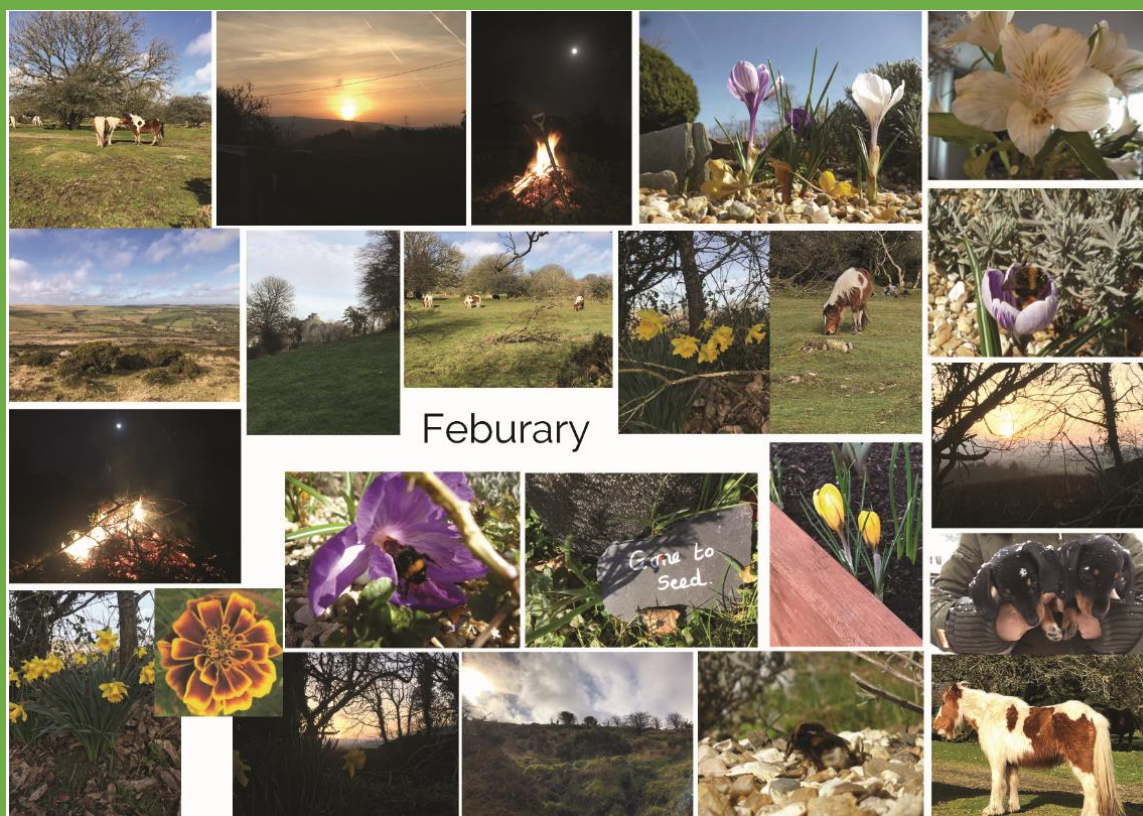
