Letters went home yesterday for anyone who has been in the Samba band during and after school clubs, and interested in taking part in the Launceston Carnival on the 12thOctober.



In Class one:

- In Maths, we will be using number bonds and related subtraction facts to 20.
- In English, we will be writing labels and captions.
- Our topic work will be map reading and going on a scavenger hunt.

In Year two, they will be:

- In English we are writing our own tales about the Warbstow Giant and the mystery of the Giants' Chair
- In Maths we are learning to add and subtract using pictorial representations
- In the afternoons the children will be continuing with planning and making samplers, learning about internet safety and constructing bridges.

Next week in Class 3 they will be:

- Reading, listening to and discussing a range of poems about rivers and/or water. Writing their own river and water poems.
 Adding and subtracting for maths, Year 3 using 3digit numbers and Year 4 with four-digits.
- In Art, they will be creating a tissue paper collage in the style of Katsushika Hokusai to show movement of water.

Next week Class 4 will be:

- Writing descriptive poetry focusing on the local environment.
- They will begin to look at addition and subtraction next in maths focusing on fluency, reasoning and problem solving skills.
- In History their focus will continue to be centred around the Norman invasion of Cornwall.
- Following on from their grid reference work in Geography children will be planning sensible walking routes using scales and legends as guidance.
