We currently have £466 outstanding to Chartwells, which is around 200 meals not paid for.We also have £386 owing for swimming, which is the cost of the coaches for 2 weeks.



Uniform.

Earlier on this term we were sadly let down by our new uniform supplier. As a result of this we have been shopping around. We are changing to a company called PMG. PMG are used by several Aspire schools already and we have had great feedback from staff and parents alike.

<u>ALL</u> uniform will now be ordered online by yourselves. There is a small amount of stock left in the office, but once that has gone we will not be holding a supply here.

The new online shop is available to view now. You will see that you can buy everything you could possibly need through here. The great news is, we have been able to reduce the pricing of some of the items, and have kept others the same.

Our sweatshirts have changed colour slightly, but they are a much better quality than the previous, as well as being cheaper. Over the next 5 years we hope that all the old sweatshirts will be made redundant! Cardigans are now available online.
