What have your children been learning?

This week Class 1 have been learning about prefixes. In Maths they have recapped telling the time and sharing into ½ and ¼. In topic work they have made clay models, looked for mini-beasts in the woods, and used the snipping tool in IT to insert pictures.

In English this week, Class 2 have been learning about Formula One. The children wrote notes whilst watching the start of the French Grand Prix 2018, then used them to write a Race report for that part of the race. I think we may have some future reporters among us! Maths has been all about multiplication and problem solving. Cross stitch designs are taking shape and we definitely aren't in quite as much of a tangle this week!

This week class 3 have been visited by a falconer. During her visit, she introduced the children to five different birds of prey. We then spent the day learning about the anatomy of birds, their habitats and even got to dissect some of their bird pellets; to discover what they had been eating. We have also looked at human and animal skeletons, considering the impact of evolution. In maths the children have explored how we can use a tin of baked beans to explore problem solving skills. It was a very messy lesson, but a lot of fun. In English the children have looked back at all their skills learnt in English this year, and have been given the opportunity of demonstrating all their knowledge in an imaginary story, publishing their finished product on Friday. Ending their week by producing a piece of art of their choice that reflects their experience of meeting birds of prey.
