In Class one:

- Maths, place value finding 1 more and 1 less
- English, using non-fiction books to find information about animals. writing sentences about animals.
- Topic, sewing felt animals, designing a sculpture using natural materials, using IT to locate images of animals on the computer.

In Year two, they will be:

- In English, we will need Year Two children to have **woolly hats, gloves and boots** in school on Tuesday!
- In Maths they will be exploring place value. In the afternoons they will be continuing to look at how we move around the planet.
