What have your children been learning?

This week Class 1 have been working from non-fiction books and finding facts. In Maths they have been learning about related addition and subtraction facts.

For the topic work Class 1 have been sorting and classifying animals along with making animal sculptures. Year 1 completed their phonic screening with confidence.

Class2 this week have written a fan letter to Pele or another footballer of their choice. In Maths, Year 3's have been using column addition to add money and Year 2's have been partitioning numbers to add. They located all the countries of the World Cup group stages in geography and discovered facts about Brazil.

Class 3 this week have been learning to compare and measure volume and capacity in Maths. In English, they have been learning, performing and writing poems. In Science they have learnt all about the human digestive system. In ICT they have been making Lego robots and in DT have designed a human anatomy game for younger children.

Year 6 continue to plan and design theme parks using extended sentences in writing, and have now completed Bikeability Level 2.
