## Playground Safety and Supervision

Our children's safety and wellbeing are always at the heart of everything we do. To ensure we maintain a clear and thriving learning environment, we are currently reviewing our current system.

We would like to remind parents and carers of the following current procedures:

- **Morning Drop-off:** Children in Year 1-6 may be dropped at school from **8:30 am** and should enter the back playground. At **8:40am**, we will ring the school bell for the children to line up and go into class. Children who arrive later will go straight into their classes. Children in Reception and Nursery will be greeted by Miss Manley at **8.40am** in the front playground. To ensure the site remains safe and managed, we kindly ask that children do not use any of the play equipment during this time. The gates will be closed at **8:50am**.
- **End of Day Collection:** Following the end of the school day at **3:20 pm**, parents and carers resume responsibility for their children. We respectfully request that children do not play on the grass area and avoid the use of balls and equipment on the school grounds at this time.

By working together to maintain these clear safety standards, we can prevent accidents and ensure our playground remains a safe and secure environment for all.
