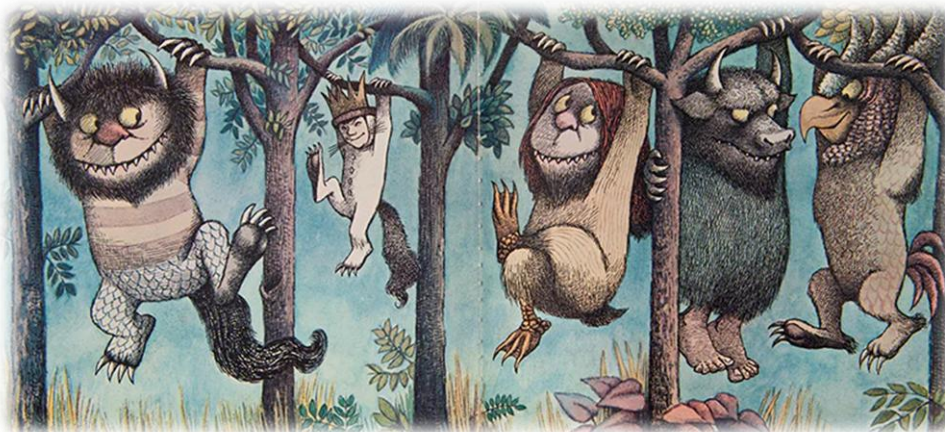
## End of Term Reflections
