

Welcome to Attenborough Class

We are delighted to welcome you back into the Summer 2 term 2025-26 for Attenborough Class.

Please find important information below to help settle into the term:

Mrs Measom will be taking Attenborough every Monday; Ms Davies will be taking the class the rest of the week (Tuesday to Friday).

PE days – Tuesday (Striking and fielding) Thursday (Tennis)

Children are allowed to come dressed in the appropriate clothing for the afternoon activities of PE on Tuesday and Thursday. Trainers must be worn for PE and dark, plain jogging bottoms/shorts and school hoodies can also be worn. With the summer months approaching please can you make sure that your child has sun cream applied before they come to school, along with a sun hat and a water bottle.

Maths

This term we are starting with fractions and then moving onto telling the time. Please can you use every opportunity to help your child with analogue and digital times. This is an area that many children find difficult, along with using, giving change from and counting money. We are still practising our times tables (Y1/2 – counting on in/ sharing between groups of 2s, 5s and 10s/ Times tables and division using these times tables. Y3 are still practising times tables to 3x, 4x, 6x and 8x. Please can you spend some time with your child, helping them to revise and practise times tables. TTRS, Numbots and now Maths.co.uk are still being used in school and are available to use at home. The new log ins for Maths.co.uk will be coming home in their yellow books by the end of next week.

Homework arrangements –Reading

Daily reading is important for every child – please ensure your child reads every school day and if you can, over the weekend too. Reading books will be changed and reading records checked by the leader of your child's phonics/ reading group. Children who are now 'off phonics' are expected to change their own books from the class library, once they have read the book. The book choices for these children are recorded in class. Every child is read with once a week in class and house points are given in order to celebrate regular reading. Please can you continue to record in the yellow reading records every time that your child reads with you. Recording = House points! The summer term is one where many children make good progress and so regular reading is really beneficial.

Library

Children will visit the library every **Friday** and have the opportunity to bring a book home for pleasure. Library books will need to be returned before another can be taken home on the following **Friday**

This will still be celebrated at the end of each term although we still encourage outside achievement certificates to be shown in Friday's assembly to the rest of the school.
