Time to Move Holiday Programme

If your child is eligible for Free School meals under the Pupil Premium agenda , they are entitled to a Fully funded (free) place on this program. It is a fantastic opportunity for them to try new activities, make friends, and stay active during the school break.

The Time2Move Holiday Programme provides fun physical activity and healthy food for children aged between 5 and 16 years old during the school holidays in Cornwall.

The programme is fully funded by the Department for Education for children that are eligible for benefits related free school meals. Whilst our programme is funded to provide holiday activities for children in receipt of benefits-related free school meals, we also encourage the approved activity providers to offer paid spaces so that even more children and families across Cornwall can potentially benefit.

Healthy Start

If you're more than 10 weeks pregnant or have a child under 4, you may be entitled to get help to buy healthy food and milk.

If you're eligible, you'll be sent a Healthy Start card with money on it that you can use in some UK shops. Your card will be topped up every 4 weeks.

You can use your card to buy:

- plain liquid cow's milk
- fresh, frozen, and tinned fruit and vegetables
- fresh, dried, and tinned pulses
- infant formula milk based on cow's milk

You can also use your card to collect:

- Healthy Start vitamins – these support you during pregnancy and breastfeeding
- vitamin drops for babies and young children – these are suitable from birth to 4 years old

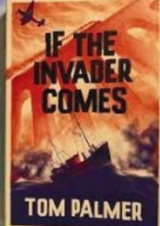
