Each year group covers the following English Subjects, in line with the National Curriculum. The order in which they are studied, will depend on how they are linked, to the inspire curriculum, topics' and planning.

**Year three** *Grammar and punctuation developing their understanding of grammar to use fronted adverbials and possessive apostrophe. Writing and composition extend their understanding of how to produce work through exploration of different genres. Comprehension to identify, respond to, discuss and write in non-fiction and fiction text Hand writing develop joined handwriting through all their work*

#### **Year one**



*Grammar and punctuation using correct sentence structure Writing extending their writing to link sentences Comprehension Sharing a wide range of text to develop their ability to understand and respond appropriately. Hand writing using handwriting pens for correct letter formation. Spelling learning to spell and use the words on the year 1 spelling list.*

**Year four** *Grammar and punctuation using their knowledge of grammatical features of different text to improve their understanding of text Writing and composition writing and identifying different genres using extended sentences with more than one clause, within paragraphs Comprehension identify, respond, discuss non-fiction and fiction text including inference questions Spelling year 3/4 spelling list.*



#### **Year five**



*Grammar and punctuation use increasingly complex grammatical structure distinguishing between plural and singular Writing and composition writing improve and edit using different genres. Developing a confidence to use extended vocabulary to engage a specific audience. Comprehension identify key features (including inference) of increasingly detailed genres Spelling year 5/6 spelling list, spelling the 3/4 list correctly in all writing*

#### **Year two**



*Grammar and punctuation develop their ability to use extended sentence structure in the correct tense Writing and composition extending their writing to explore different genres Comprehension Sharing a wide range of text to develop their ability to understand and respond appropriately. Hand writing using handwriting pens to develop joined handwriting skills Spelling learning year 2 spelling list.*

**Year six** *Grammar and punctuation use increasingly complex grammatical structure and understand how it impacts on the structure of text within different genres. Writing and composition able to identify write improve and edit using different genres independently. Comprehension respond, discuss and answer all to different genres accurately. Spelling consistently using all spellings accurately in all areas of learning*
