After the summer break, school will be reopening to all pupils, on Monday 7th September. I will send out additional details of new timings and measures to follow. These will ensure the smooth start to the year and the safety of all in school, in light of guidance issued by the government relating to COVID 19.

Classes next year will reduce to 3 from 4.

Class 1 will have Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 (infants). A class of 26. Mrs Sobey and Mrs Harvey will both be teaching in class 1, supported by Mrs S Reeves.

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Mr Turnham will be teaching, supported by Mrs V Somers.
