Ukraine

The news about the Russian invasions of Ukraine has brought worldwide shock and condemnation. As best we can we shield the children from the news that may cause distress or worry. However, the 'chatter' they may have had access to via the TV or radio, may lead to questions. Any discussions are always handled sensitively but in an informed manner which provides simple facts, and reassurances that there is no direct impact on them. The BBC's Newsround programme seeks to set out a very simplified version of the news for children and may be helpful. We held an assembly this week in which we thought about the children and families in Ukraine. We have reminded the children that if they have any worries or concerns about this, or anything at all, they can talk to any adult in school. An open and warm response to children's questions is vital to give them the reassurance that as adults, we will provide them with a safe and nurturing environment and one where they can talk to us about anything. If you have any concern or wish to alert us to any questions your child has been asking at home, please do get in touch.
