FROM THE HEAD OF SCHOOL

This week has again been a busy week. I have had a meeting with the County Council and contractors about the works they will be conducting in the school over the summer. This summer will see the contractors starting phase 1 of the damp proofing and new floors for Class 2, 4 and the library. Due to the complex nature of the work they are only completing phase 1 this summer and will complete phase 2 next summer. This will mean that the school is out of bounds throughout the holidays and possibly the front playground.

I also had a great meeting with Lynette Hutchinson from the Parish Council, where we were able to update her with all the works that will be going on over the summer and all the changes happening at the school and the community hall.

With the changes happening with our kitchen and the new jobs that have been created, we are hoping to be able to run a breakfast club for all pupils, including Pre-School. This will enable parents to drop off at the hall from 7.45am. We hope that this will be a success and if so will look at the possibility of running an after school care club until 5/5.30pm to provide wrap around care for parents. We are really excited to be welcoming L.E.D to Warbstow on Monday 22nd July. They will deliver an hour long assembly to class 4 in a rock concert format.
