



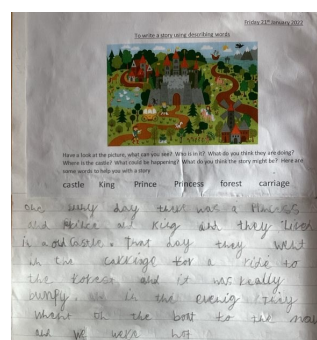
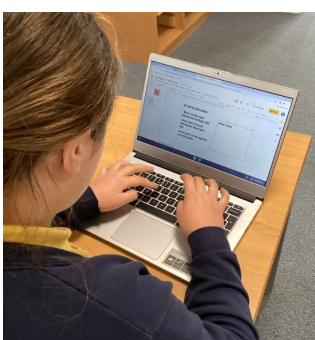
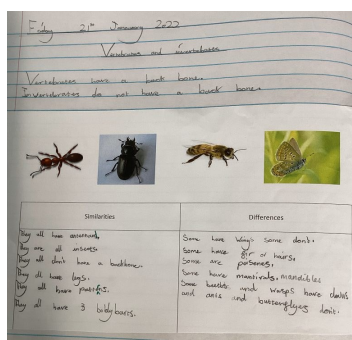

## Warbstow's Covid Outbreak Management Plan

I have met with Aspire's Health and Safety Team and Public Health England today, they are encouraged by what looks to be a decline in our case numbers. We have been under an outbreak plan for 10 days now which has been tough for everyone but the priority is always to keep everybody safe. We are very grateful for your support. The last stage is to monitor our cases over the weekend, if we are in the same positive situation on Monday afternoon we can start to move to 'softer measures' from Tuesday. I will communicate with you on Monday. Monday, however, will remain under the measures we currently have. I would urge anyone who develops symptoms to get a PCR test and ongoing LFT testing is advised. We did pick up some asymptomatic cases with the blanket PCR testing last week and so it is important to remain vigilant. We are hearing from PHE that one symptom in children can be a rash, and sickness.

Please report any test results into the school office over the weekend.
